



A note for parents

At Global Grad we prioritise the welfare of our students throughout the duration of their studies and travels whilst enrolled on our semesters. Our structured approach and the small cohort of students in each location aims to promote a supportive and inclusive learning community and environment.

As a parent, we welcome your involvement in every step of your son or daughter's journey with Global Grad. Being part of Global Grad is one of the most rewarding and broadening experiences your son or daughter can undertake. Within a single semester, they will gain a unique understanding of the world, enhancing their academic inspiration and growth.

Health and Safety

The Global Grad team take time to assess all the potential risk factors of studying and travelling abroad because above all else, the health and safety of our students is our highest priority. During management training, the Area and Location Managers spent time in their designated cities; therefore, have an in-depth knowledge of all potential risks and take all possible migrating steps to create a safe experience for our students. In addition to our own specialised team, Global Grad is working with a number of tourism companies who are the most specialised in their fields to maximise student safety.

Emotional wellbeing

Global Grad has integrated a first-class support system into its programme with our pastoral support available 24/7 during each semester.

Our Location Managers are trained in pastoral support and will aim to support student's emotional well-being with each student being treated as an individual. Some students take longer to adapt to being away from home than others and we are always on hand to discuss any issues or concerns that they may have enabling us to offer appropriate advice. Where required, one-to-one meetings will be held regularly with students to ensure their emotional well-being is supported.

Physical health

In addition to our Location Managers being fully trained in first aid, our study hubs are situated in close proximity of a hospital and English-speaking doctors. To join a Global Grad semester, our students must have travel insurance. A few weeks before a semester departure, we will be arranging calls with every student to ensure they have a thorough understanding of health and safety and their responsibilities.
